120 hours are required for graduation from the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. At least 40 credit hours of the 120 hours needed for graduation must be in upper division courses - courses numbered 300 or above.

4 <u>Butler Cultural Requirements (BCR)</u> must also be documented before graduation, except for majors within Jordan College of the Arts.

1 SJD course must also be completed, either in the major or in electives.

**NOTE**: The 33 hour French major affords considerable flexibility in completion paths, and leaves room for additional French courses, the addition of a minor, and in some cases, a second major if desired. 300 and 400 level classes may be taken in different orders, depending upon availability and student needs. While these guidelines are recommended, students need not complete all 4 100-200 level language courses at Ivy Tech; they also may use some of their elective hours at Butler to complete any Butler core requirements that they did not complete at Ivy Tech. Also, speakers who have acquired language skills in high school courses or elsewhere may take a language placement test, and, after completing upper level French courses at Butler, receive placement credits based upon courses that they placed out of.
