**Subject:** Important Announcement from Health Services

Dear Butler Community,

A Butler student has been diagnosed with positive Influenza A. At this time, the Indiana State Department of Health suggests all positive Influenza A tests be treated as the H1N1 influenza.

In accordance with their recommendation, this individual has been confined to a single-person room and bathroom in his fraternity house Sigma Nu. He will remain isolated until he is fever-free for at least 24 hours without medication. Bathrooms and common spaces throughout the fraternity house are in the process of being thoroughly cleaned.

We ask that every member of the Butler community continue to practice good hygiene such as thoroughly washing hands, wiping down surface areas with disinfectants and staying away from others if you feel sick. A complete list of personal hygiene recommendations can be found [here](#).

Signs and symptoms of H1N1 include:

- Fever above 100.4
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Body aches
- Headache
- Chills
- Fatigue

Anyone experiencing these symptoms should seek medical advice immediately. Butler students can call Health Services at (317) 940-9385. Faculty and staff should contact their family physician or visit a minute clinic.
