1. Follow Up on Student with Influenza A

The Butler student diagnosed with positive Influenza A has been fever-free without medication for more than 24 hours and thus has returned to class.

While Health Services has not received reports of any new cases of Influenza A, Butler and other universities will all likely see more cases throughout the fall semester. If you have flu-like symptoms, you are encouraged to seek medical attention from your doctor or at the Health Center, if you are a student. Per the recommendation of the CDC for institutions of higher learning, students with respiratory symptoms and a fever will be asked to wear a mask in the Health Center. If the student is diagnosed with positive Influenza A, they will be asked to wear the mask until they are self-isolated.
