Break Games – These games count toward class credit & for travel “credit.”

Why commit to Blue or White band? – For NCAA or NIT post-season play, the 30 member travel band is comprised of the 15 Blue & 15 White band members. Those students have the “right of first refusal” to decline post-season games. If you are unable to travel, let the office know and we will offer your spot to “At Large” members based on seniority, attendance and instrumentation needs.

Beyond the membership commitment to the Blue or the White bands, ANY BUBB member may attend ANY game they wish. If you are not assigned to the Blue or White band, you are an “At Large” member.

“At Large Membership”??? – “At Large members are not restricted in any way as to which games they may play and are encouraged to attend every game their schedule will permit. Your chance to travel post-season improves with your attendance.

Attendance – To earn class credit, you must perform for at least 12 of the 22 non-break games and attend a minimum of two required rehearsals (B/W Band members will need to attend more than just your assigned games for full class credit). **NOTE – HORIZON LEAGUE TOURNAMENT GAMES ARE CONSIDERED PART OF THE REGULAR BLUE/WHITE REQUIRED SCHEDULES**
