The Certificate in Piano Pedagogy at Butler University is designed to meet the needs of current and prospective piano teachers who have not and/or will not have the time and resources to pursue a traditional degree program in piano pedagogy. The Certificate program also provides the opportunity for the independent piano teacher to enhance and update his/her skills in teaching and performance.

All sixteen hours in the Certificate program must be earned at Butler. No student enrolled in a degree program may earn the Certificate in Piano Pedagogy.

Students in the Certificate program will be admitted to the University as non-degree candidates. Certificate candidates must complete all sixteen semester hours at Butler with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.000.

Applicants for the Certificate program will audition in piano before a committee of the piano faculty for admission/placement.* Applicants who demonstrate a deficiency in piano may be required to complete a prescribed number of hours in Keyboard Skills.

*An audition is required but may be delayed until the end of the second semester of piano study if the student elects to enroll for secondary credit for two semesters.
