H1N1 Vaccine Clinics

Butler has received 500 doses of the H1N1 vaccine and plans to hold two vaccination clinics tomorrow, Thursday, Dec. 3. Vaccines are available at no cost on a first come, first serve basis and no appointment is necessary.

- 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the basement of the College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences building (enter the door facing Lilly Hall to access stairs leading to the basement).
- 9 a.m. to noon in Health Services (located inside the Health & Recreation Complex)

The vaccine will **only** be administered to Butler students, faculty and staff who fit the criteria one of these priority groups:

- If you are under 24 years of age
- If you are pregnant
- If you provide care for or live with an infant that is less than 6 months of age
- If you are a healthcare provider or you have direct contact with patients in a healthcare setting
- If you have any of the following medical conditions:
 - Lung problems such as asthma, emphysema, chronic bronchitis
 - Diabetes Mellitus
 - Heart Disease (not including high blood pressure)
 - Kidney disease
 - Liver disease
 - Suppressed immune system [caused by recent cancer treatment or Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV), or medications]
