Undergraduate Concentrations and Emphases

The following areas of Concentration (24-35 credit hours) and Emphasis (15-18 hours) are not stand-alone degrees. Rather, they are to be completed along with another music degree program, usually the BA Music degree. Students in the BA Music (and other music degree programs) may elect to complete one or more of these areas of Concentration or Emphasis. Adding a Concentration/Emphasis requires the approval of the appropriate music faculty; an audition and/or interview will normally be required. Completion of one or more of these will be shown on the student's transcript upon graduating from Butler. At least 50% of the credits in any concentration or emphasis must be unique to that program and may not overlap with another concentration/emphasis, major, or minor (except as free electives).
