Military courses are evaluated on a case-bycase basis. An official JST transcript is required. There is no credit minimum or maximum. ACE recommendations are considered, but courses must fit within one of our academic programs in order to receive credit. Not much credit is usually granted because most courses do not align with the curriculum. JST also doesn't transfer because we require letter grades of C- or better and JST coursework is often listed as Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory or Pass/Fail
