Music education majors are exempt from the Perspectives in the Creative Arts requirement (because they take 9 credit hours in the arts), the Social World requirement (because they take 9 credit hours of education (ED) courses), and from the Butler Cultural Requirement.

Music students must attend 16 performances/events per year; for students who are student teaching, studying abroad, or in fulltime internships during the academic year, only 8 performances are required for that year. See the School of Music website for distribution requirements.
