

MUSIC MINOR

A Minor in Music is available through the School of Music to students whose primary major is not in music. It consists of twenty-four (24) credit hours, of which fourteen to sixteen (14-16) are specified. An audition is not required. These required hours for the Music Minor are listed below:

The remaining hours are unspecified and may be taken in Applied Music, Diction, Ensemble, Music Education, Music History, or Music Theory.

The minimum acceptable grade for all required music courses is 2.0 (C).

The Music Minor has the following performance attendance requirement: the student must attend a minimum of 16 events during his/her matriculation at Butler, regardless of the number of semesters of enrollment as an official Music Minor. Of these events, 8 must be in music, 2 in dance, 2 in theatre, 2 in art or arts-related lecture events, and 2 of the student's choice. Records are maintained in the JCA office.

Students fulfill the Perspectives of the Creative Arts requirement of the University Core Curriculum when they have completed 9 credit hours of music courses.
