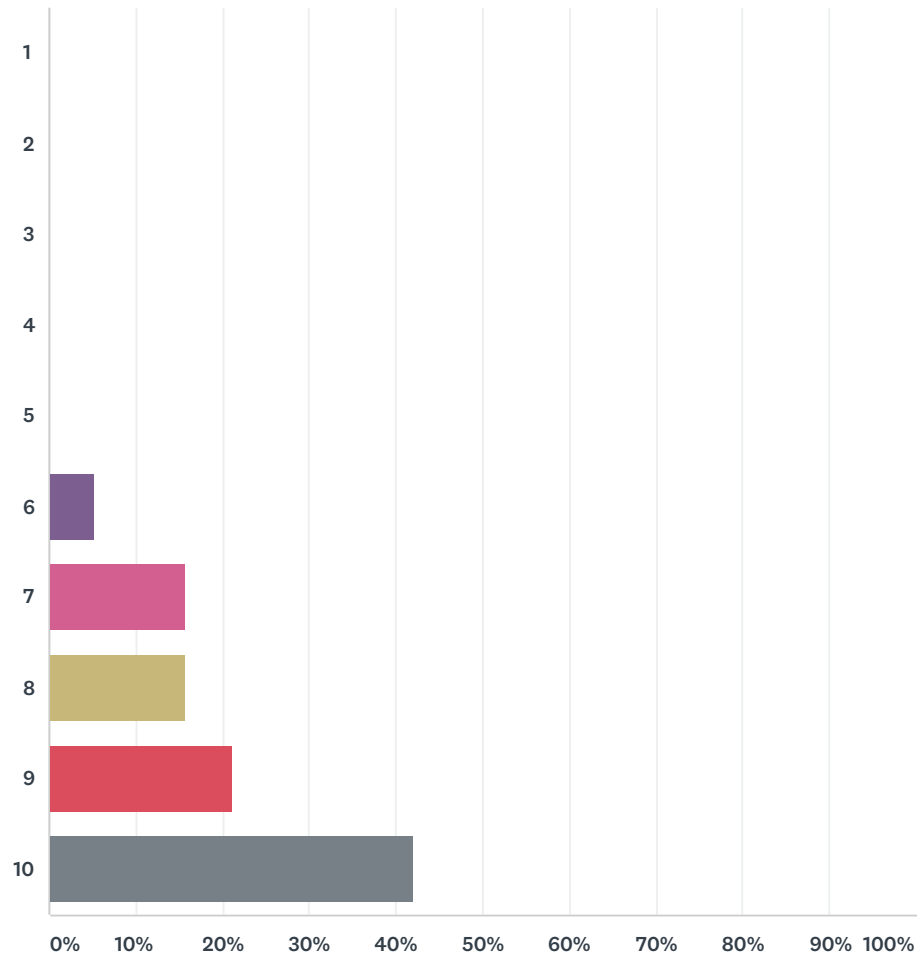


Q1 Communication - How would you rate the Interview Day communication between Butler and your school/district with 10 being the highest?

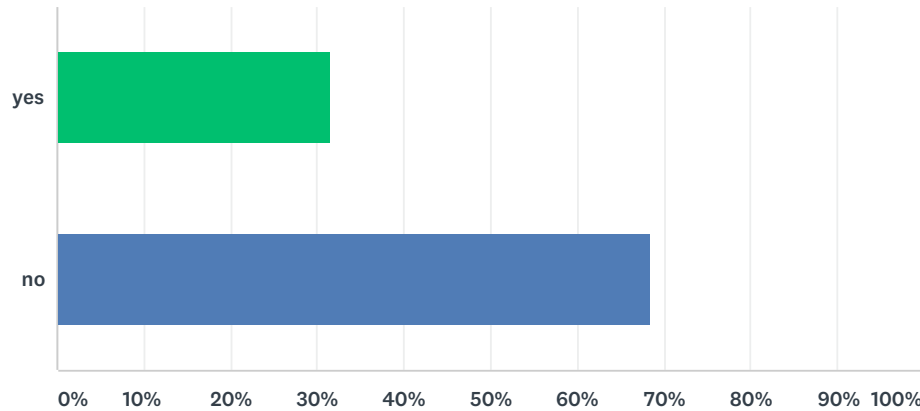

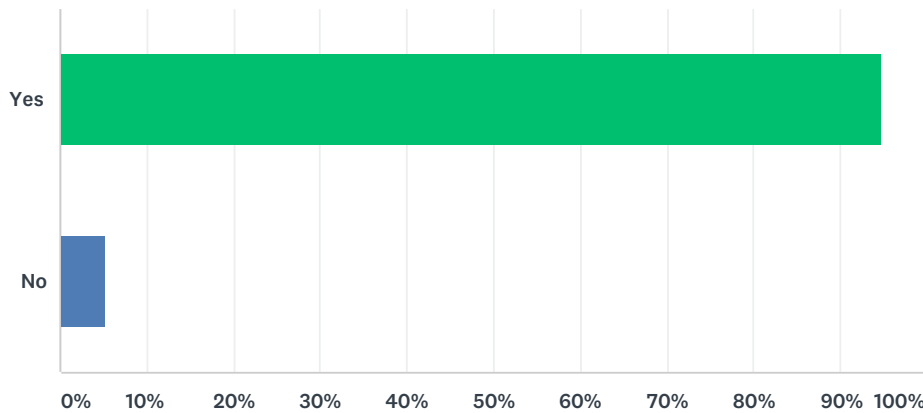

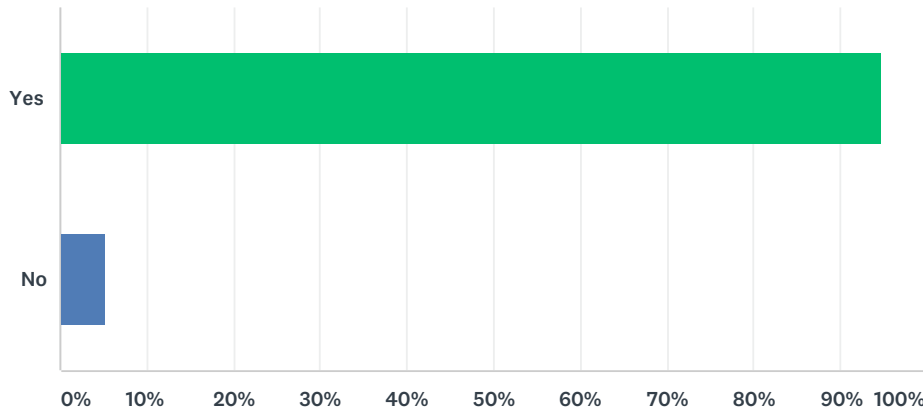

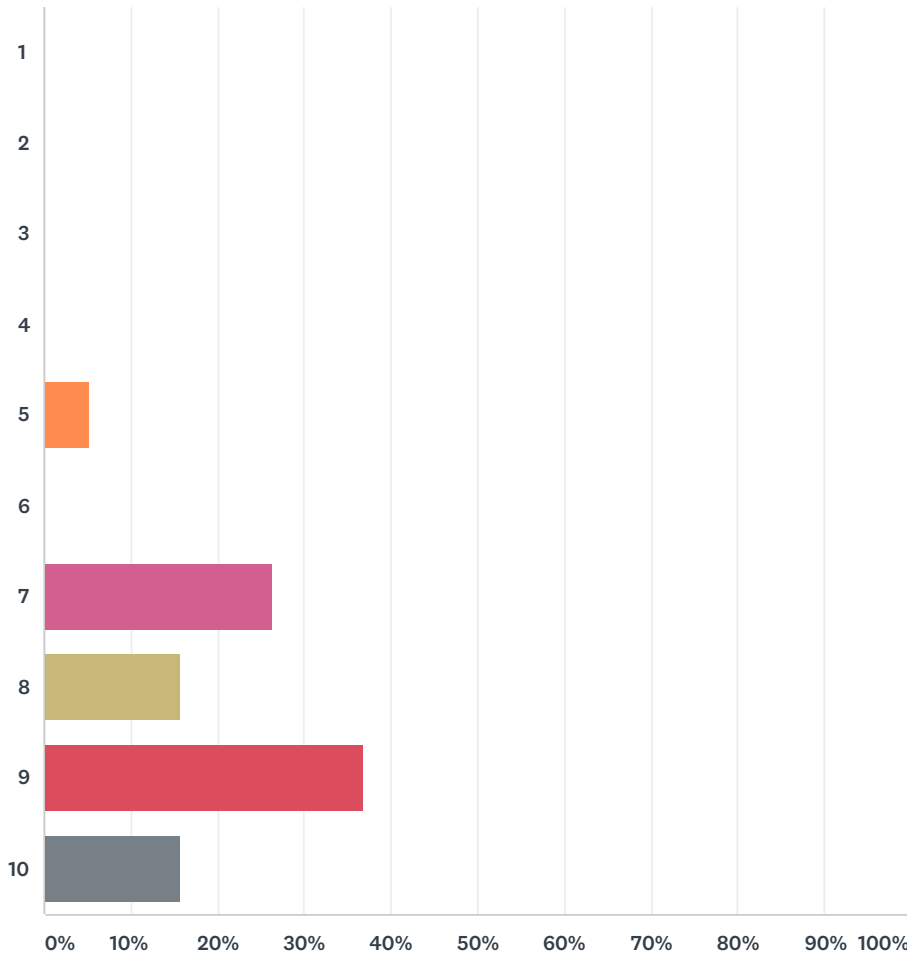
