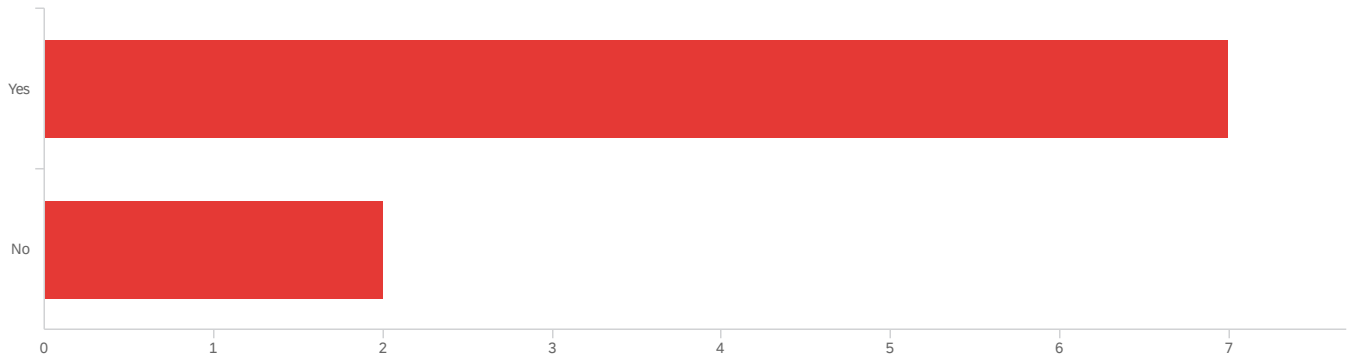

Q1 - Does your school employ a school counselor who graduated from Butler University in the past 3 years?



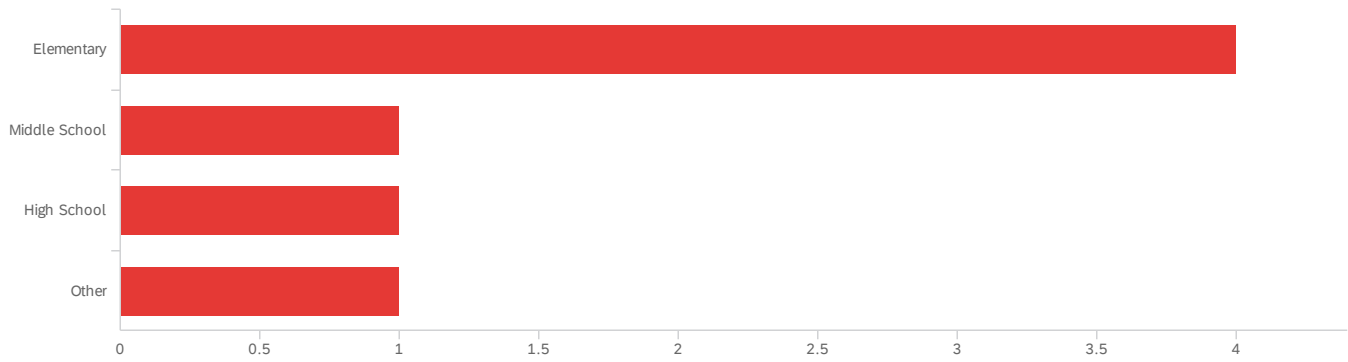

## Q2 - What developmental level does your school serve?



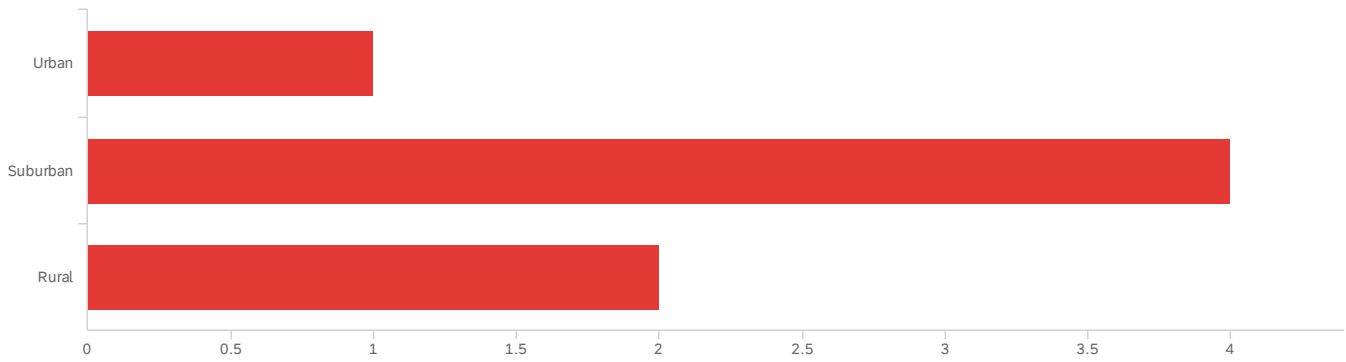

### Q3 - In what setting is your school located?



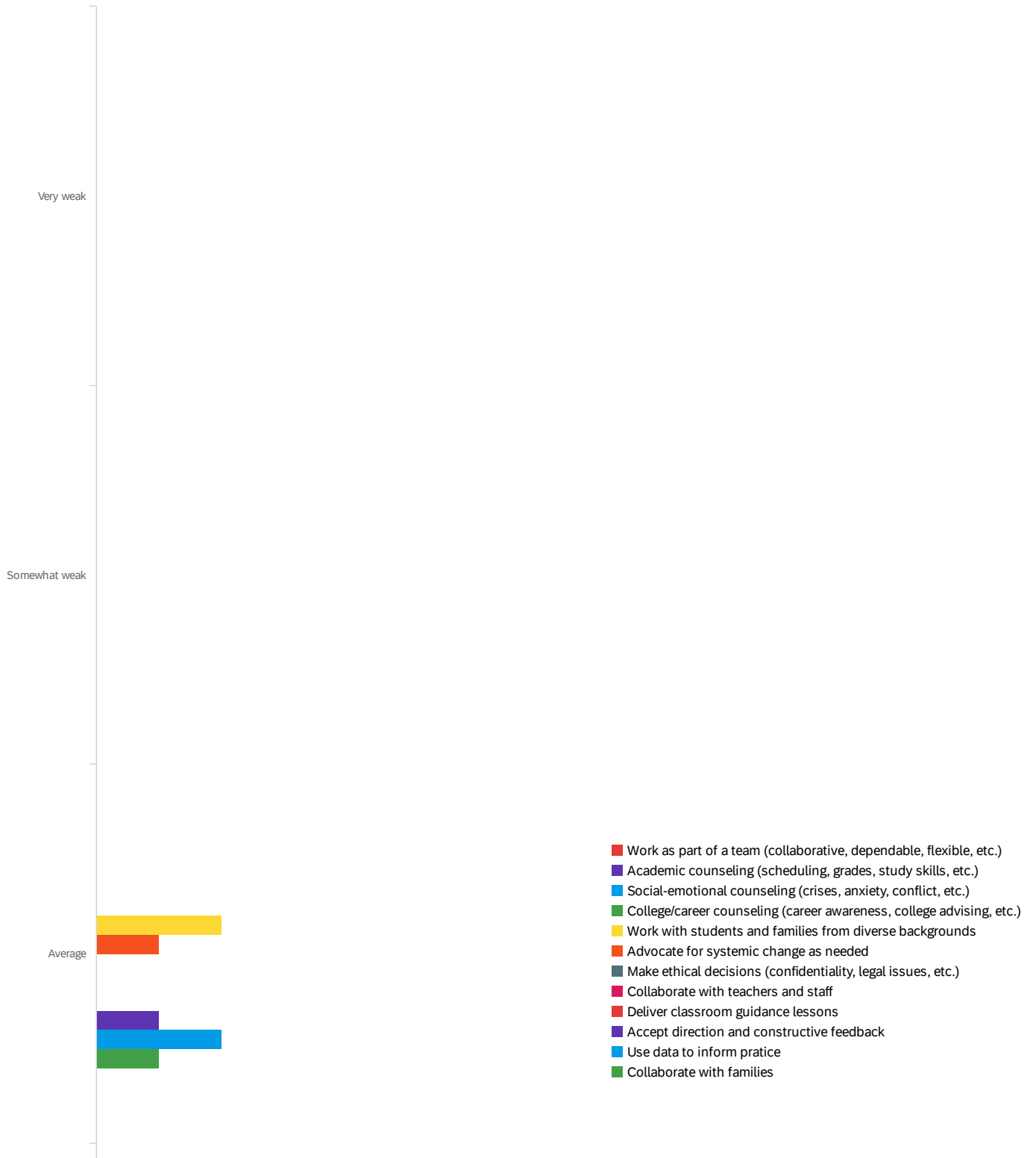

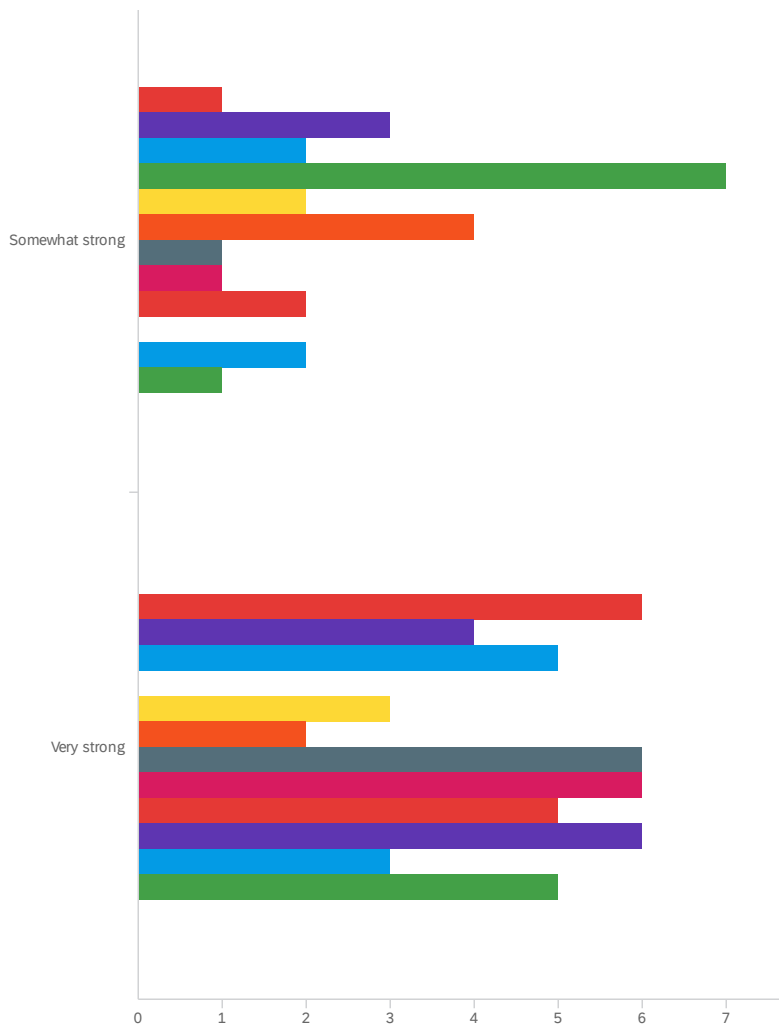

University in the past 3 years, please rate their abilities in the following areas on a scale from 1 (Very Weak) to 5 (Very Strong).



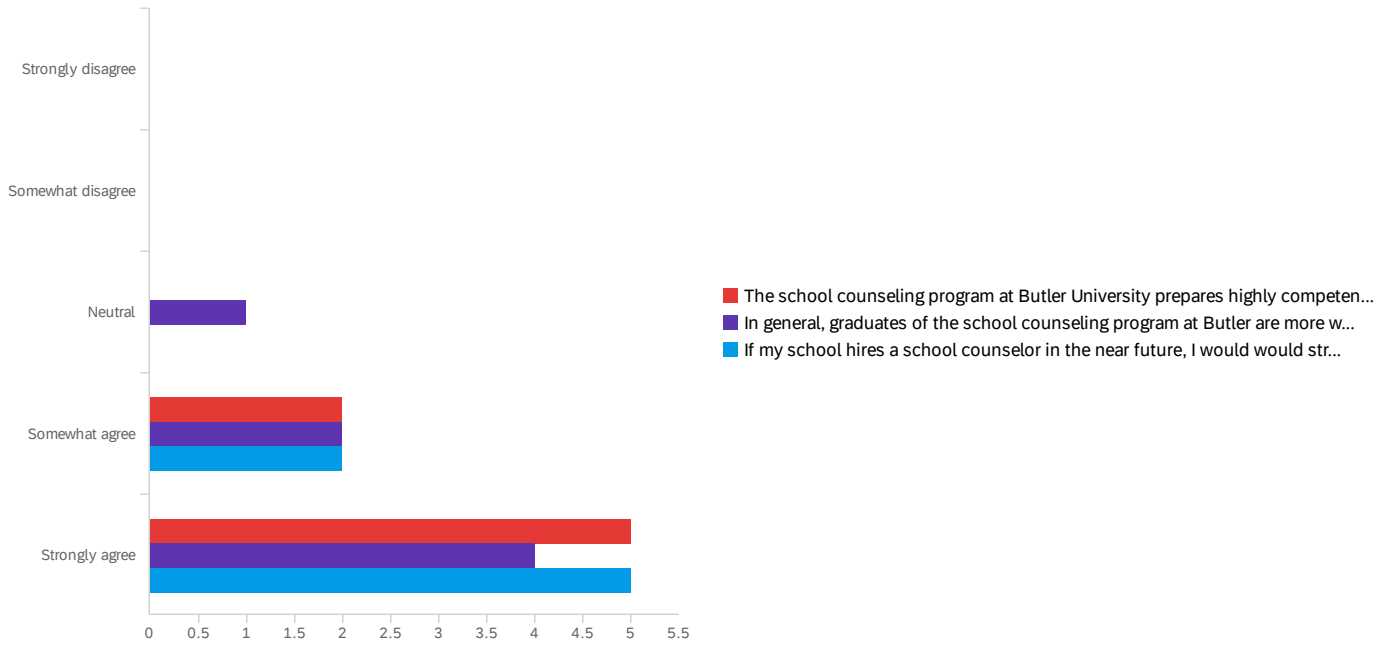
