



BUTLER UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL STUDENT POST-ARRIVAL CHECKLIST:

- Check in with Office of International Student Services.

At check-in bring:

- Passport
- Visa
- I-94 card (white card you received upon arrival into the U.S.)
- Stamped I-20/DS-2019
- Completed health form (unless you already submitted it to the Health Center)
- Proof of Health Insurance*
- International Student Data Sheet

* F1 and J1 undergraduates will be automatically enrolled in the University-sponsored health insurance plan (ISEP participants exempted). Graduate students need to provide proof of health insurance.

- Call home to family and friends to let them know you made it safely
- Locate permanent housing and update local address with OISS
- Take or send verification of immunizations and physical exam to Health Services located in the HRC according to directions found here: <http://www.butler.edu/health-services/forms/>
- Meet your Academic Advisor
- Register for classes (if you have not already done so)
- Get your Butler ID card
- Attend mandatory International Orientation
