- The B.A. degree in Music requires 124 credits.

• The double major of Music and Economics will fulfill the following Areas of Inquiry in the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives of the Creative Arts, The Social World, and Analytic Reasoning; 12 hours of "University Electives" and 3 hours of "LAS Electives" in the Economics degree are satisfied by music courses. In addition, the B.A. Music curriculum fulfills the Social Justice and Diversity requirement of the Butler University Core Curriculum; music majors are exempted from the Butler Cultural Requirement because of the arts event attendance requirements for all arts majors. The Indianapolis Community Requirement is satisfied by LSB 401 and LSB 402 in the Economics curriculum.

• The student will be assigned a Lacy School of Business advisor in addition to their Music advisor.
