- The B.A. degree in Music requires 124 credits.

• The double major of Music and Journalism will fulfill the following Areas of Inquiry in the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives of the Creative Arts and The Social World. In addition, the B.A. Music curriculum fulfills the Social Justice and Diversity requirement of the Butler University Core Curriculum; music majors are exempted from the Butler Cultural Requirement because of the arts event attendance requirements for all arts majors. The Indianapolis Community Requirement is NOT satisfied.
