## B.A. IN ART + DESIGN PLUS A SECONDARY MAJOR IN PSYCHOLOGY

- The B.A. degree in Art + Design requires 126 credits. 40 hours must be 300 or 400 -level courses.

- The double major of Art + Design and Psychology will fulfill the following Areas of Inquiry in the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives of the Creative Arts and The Social World. In addition, the B.A. Art + Design curriculum fulfills the Indianapolis Community Requirement and the Social Justice and Diversity requirement of the Butler University Core Curriculum; art majors are exempted from the Butler Cultural Requirement because of the arts event attendance requirements for all arts majors.
- The student will be assigned a Psychology advisor in addition to their Art advisor.
- Students are encouraged to register as soon as their "window" opens; psychology classes fill quickly. No more than 3 psychology classes may be taken in a single semester.
