- The B.A. degree in Theatre requires 124 credits.

• The English major has four tracks: Literature; Creative Writing; Literary Theory, Culture, and Criticism; and Professional Writing. The eight-semester plan below is for the Literature track; the additional courses needed to complete the other tracks are listed in the Summary.

• The double major of Theatre and English will fulfill the following Areas of Inquiry in the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives of the Creative Arts and Texts and Ideas. In addition, the B.A. Theatre curriculum fulfills the Indianapolis Community Requirement and the Social Justice and Diversity requirement of the Butler University Core Curriculum; theatre majors are exempted from the Butler Cultural Requirement because of the arts event attendance requirements for all arts majors.

• The student will be assigned an English advisor in addition to their Theatre advisor.
