- \*Music students who receive a JCA Talent Award must take Applied Lessons (AM) at the major level and must participate in a major ensemble every semester they are on campus.

- A grade of C or higher is required for all JCA courses.
- For students considering a career as a professional musician and/or graduate studies in music, adding the BA in Music as a secondary major (14 additional music credits) is recommended.
- Arts Administration majors who add a secondary major in music are required to follow the School of Music arts event attendance requirements for three years, and the Arts Administration requirements for one year. See the School of Music website for distribution requirements for music majors.
