



Center for Athletic Medicine is looking for a responsible Physician Assistant to support the doctors' work and actively facilitate patients' recovery. You will apply medical techniques and principles under the direction of a physician, and you will deal with a diverse set of patients offering them care and encouragement.

Responsibilities

- Assess patients' health and their demands and aim to fulfill them as well as possible. Sees patients both independently and with supervision.
- Order appropriate tests and develop patient treatment plan.
- Issue appropriate prescriptions under the supervision of the physician, perform joint injections and aspirations.
- Inform physicians about any problems or discrepancies that might arise
- Acquire and review patient histories identifying abnormal conditions
- Monitor patients' progress and keep records of treatments, surgeries, or other medical events
- Attend to emergencies
- Assist as a first assistant with major or minor surgical procedures in the operating room within the scope of licensure, including but not limited to closing wounds, preparing grafts, positioning, and draping patients, securing proper instruments, equipment. Etc.
- Prepare patients for examinations and conduct routine procedures
- Provide therapeutic treatments (disinfecting wounds, suturing, casting, etc.)
- Performs pre-surgical history and ensures surgical clearance is completed.
- Prescribes and orders appropriate durable medical equipment such as braces, CPM and generates a letter of medical necessity
- Assist with preparations of independent medical exams, record review for NFL player and W/C cases.
- Provides continuity of care by developing and implementing patient management plans.
